Stamps: Bubble Over (145868), Bubble Over Bundle (145663)

Inks: Basic Black Archival (140931). Lemon Lime Twist (144086). Basic Grav Archival (140932)

Paper: Whisper White (100730), Bermuda Bay (131197), Basic Gray (121044), Bubble & Fizz Designer Series Paper

(SAB 2018), Silver Foil Sheet (132178)

Accents: Lemon Lime Twist 3/8" Mini Striped Ribbon (145611), Glitter & Clear Epoxy Shapes (145632)

Tools: Bottles & Bubbles Framelits (145663), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Stampin Dimensionals (104430),

Mini Glue Dots (103683), Tear & Tape Adhesive (138995), Paper Trimmer (126889), Big Shot (143263)

Measurements:

Bermuda Bay card stock (Card Base): 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"

Basic Gray card stock: 4" x 5-1/4"

Whisper White card stock: $4" \times 5-1/4"$ piece for inside panel, $3-3/4" \times 5"$ for card front, scrap for Stitched Shape circle Bubbles & Fizz Designer Series Paper: $1" \times 3-3/4"$ strips of assorted patterns (strips), one soda pop bottle cut out

Silver Foil Sheet: scrap for bottle top

3/8" Lemon Lime Twist Striped Ribbon: 12" piece

Instructions:

- 1. Adhere 1" x 3-3/4" strips of Bubbles & Fizz Designer Series Paper to the 3-3/4" x 5" piece of Whisper White card stock (use photo for reference). Mount onto 4" x -1/4" Basic Gray layer.
- 2. Using the Bottles & Bubbles Framelits, die-cut a bottle image from the Bubbles & Fizz DSP.
- 3. Die-cut a Silver Foil bottle cap with same framelits and adhere to top of the bottle.
- 4. Stamp the Bubble Over sentiment in Basic Gray Archival ink onto a Stitched Shapes Framelits die-cut circle. (refer to photo for placement).
- 5. Stamp the bubbles above the sentiment in Lemon Lime Twist ink.
- 6. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive to the back of the circle and add Lemon Lime Twist Striped Ribbon as shown.
- 7. Pop circle up with Dimensionals onto the card front.
- 8. Add a few Glitter & Clear Epoxy Shapes "bubbles" to bring the Lemon Lime stamped bubbles to life.
