- STAMPS Sea of Textures (146485w, 146488c), Sea of Textures Bundle (148357w, 148358c)
- PAPER Fresh Fig (144242), Night of Navy (100867), Crumb Cake (120953, Mint Macaron (138337), Whisper White (100730), Tranquil Textures Designer Series Paper (DSP) (146331)
- INK Night of Navy (147110)
- OTHER Night of Navy Medium Baker's Twine (146336), Under The Sea Framelits (146334), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Big Shot (143263), SNAIL Adhesive (104332), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

## Cutting & Scoring:

- Fresh Fig 4-1/4" x 11", score and fold at 5-1/2"; scrap for die-cutting sand dollar
- Night of Navy 3-5/8" x 4-7/8"; scrap for die-cutting sand dollar
- Crumb Cake 3 x 4" scrap for die-cutting netting
- Mint Macaron scrap for die-cutting starfish
- Whisper White 3" x 2" for sentiment label
- Tranquil Textures DSP 3-1/2" x 2-1/2" bubbles pattern; 3-1/2" x 2-1/4" Mint Macaron pattern
- Night of Navy Medium Twine 14"

## Instructions:

- Adhere both DSP pieces onto the Night of Navy layer.
- Tie Baker's Twine around the layers on the seam, finishing off with a bow.
- Pop up the layer onto the Fresh Fig card base.
- Die-cut the netting from Crumb Cake cardstock using Under The Sea Framelits. Adhere to the card front with SNAIL in the center that will be covered with the greeting.
- Die-cut a Night of Navy large and Fresh Fig small sand dollar using the Under The Sea Framelits. Attach to the card front with Glue Dots.
- Stamp the Sea of Textures sentiment in Night of Navy ink onto Whisper White card stock, die-cut with the Stitched Shapes oval framelit, then pop up with Dimensionals.
- Die-cut a small sand dollar from Mint Macaron, then attach the center starfish shape to the sentiment label with a Glue Dot.
