

Many Messages – Masculine Birthday



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Many Messages (154510)
- **Card Stock** – Basic White (159276); Smoky Slate (131202); Basic Gray (121044)
- **Stamp Pads** – Tuxedo Black Memento (132708)
- **Misc.** – Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); In Good Taste Designer Series Paper (DSP)(152494); Bone Folder (102300); Stitched Triangles Dies (152710); Messages Dies (154422); Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing Folder (152718); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Paper Snips (103579); Die Cutting and Embossing Machine

Measurements:

- Smoky Slate: 5 ½" x 8 ½", 4 1/8" x 5 3/8"
- In Good Taste DSP: 2 different patterns – 2 1/8" x 4"
(I used the one sheet that has the gray and white horizontal bricks on one side and solid gray on back)
- Basic White: 2 1/8" x 5 3/8", 4" x 5 1/4", scrap for sentiment and mask
- Basic Gray: 2 ½" x 5 3/8"

Instructions:

1. Fold the Smoky Slate card base in half and use bone folder to flatten the fold. Emboss smaller piece of Smoky Slate cardstock with the Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing Folder and adhere to card front.
2. Die cut 4 each Stitched Triangles (die is approximately 2" tall and 1 ¼" base) from 2 different designs from the In Good Taste DSP (8 total). Adhere to Basic White 2 1/8" x 5 5/16" piece of card stock, as shown in picture, with multipurpose liquid glue. Trim off excess and adhere to Basic Gray cardstock. Adhere this piece to card front using multipurpose liquid glue.

3. Stamp "Happy Birthday" using the Many Messages stamp and black ink on a scrap piece of Basic White card stock. (I created a mask from a scrap piece of card stock that only allowed the one sentiment to get inked.)
4. Die cut the sentiment using the Messages die. Adhere the sentiment to the card front using dimensionals.
5. Stamp remaining piece of Basic White card stock as desired and adhere to inside of card.
