

Merriest Moments Double Embossing Card



Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Merriest Moments (156783)
- **Card Stock** – Basic White (159276), Cherry Cobbler (119685), Evening Evergreen (155574), Snowy White Velvet Sheets (156405), Crushed Curry (131199), Mint Macaron (138337)
- **Stamp Pads** – Mint Macaron (147406), Cherry Cobbler (147083)
- **Misc** - Merriest Frames Hybrid Embossing Folder (156385), Stampin' Write Daffodil Delight Marker (154883), Small Styrofoam balls or Matte Decorative Dots (156289), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Measurements:

- Basic White: 8 ½ x 5 ½" scored at 4 ¼" (card base), 3" x 3" scrap
- Cherry Cobbler: 5 ¼" x 4"
- Evening Evergreen: 5 ½" x 4 ¼"
- Mint Macaron: scrap for leaves
- White Velvet: 3 ½" x 2 ½" scrap for Poinsettia
- Crushed Curry: scrap for center of Poinsettia

Instructions:

1. Emboss Cherry Cobbler piece with Hybrid Embossing Folder and adhere to white card base.
2. Die-cut the Evening Evergreen layer with the detailed Merriest Frames die. Then position the die-cut inside the folder to emboss the texture onto the layer.
3. Die cut small Basic White layer with inside of frame rectangular die.
4. Die cut two Poinsettia flowers with White Velvet scrap. Die-cut center with Crushed Curry scrap. Glue flower layers together with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Set aside.
5. Stamp leaves in Mint Macaron on Mint Macaron scrap piece and die cut with coordinating die.
6. Stamp words in top center of white rectangular piece in Cherry Cobbler. Then glue to center of Evening Evergreen piece. Glue Evening Evergreen piece on Cherry Cobbler embossed piece. Then glue Poinsettia and stamped leaf on bottom left corner of Evening Evergreen piece (see picture for placement).
7. Glue 3 small Styrofoam balls to center of poinsettia. Let dry. Then color with Crushed Curry marker. Or, use Bumblebee colored Matte Decorative Dots.
