

He's All That Hello Handsome Card



Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – He's All That (159071)
- **Paper** – Soft Succulent (155776); Basic White (159276); Early Espresso (119686); Crumb Cake (120953); He's the Man 12" x 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper (159068)
- **Ink Pads** – Versamark (102283)
- **Misc.** – Stylish Shapes Dies (159183); Basics Embossing Powders (155554); Rustic Metallic Adhesive-Backed Dots; Heat Tool (129053); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Paper Snips (103579); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Paper Trimmer (152392); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

Soft Succulent: 8 ½" x 5 ½"; score at 4 ¼"

Basic White: 5" x 3 ¾"

Early Espresso: 5 ¼" x 4"

Crumb Cake: 3" x 3"

Designer Series Paper: Strips cut to 1 ½" x 6"; 1 ¾" x 6"; 1" x 6"

Instructions:

1. Fold the Soft Succulent cardstock on score line to form card base.
2. Cut the DSP strips on the diagonal to create triangular shapes. Line up the top right corner and the lower left corner in the track of the trimmer and cut.
3. Mark the middle of the Basic White with a pencil and glue down a DSP triangle. Continue to add triangles until the piece is finished leaving a slight gap between each piece.
4. For the final two piece at the end position them to cover the space and extend over the edge.
5. Cut off the excess pieces of DSP to have a clean edge.
6. Stamp the sentiment in Versamark ink on Crumb Cake, apply Black Emboss power and heat set.
7. Cut out the circle using the Stylish Shapes dies and Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
8. Position the circle at the bottom of the starburst and cut off the bottom of the circle so it's flush with the Basic White edge.
9. Glue the decorated piece to the Early Espresso and glue both to the card front.
10. Add Rustic Metallic Adhesive Back Dots to complete the card.
